PRO SE DIVORCE TIME TABLE

Prepare Complaint and IFP at clinic

Take original and two copies to Courthouse

Take the certified copy (the one with the raised seal) and serve on Defendant by certified mail, restricted delivery, return receipt requested; sheriff; or acceptance

File affidavit of service in prothonotary's office. (Courthouse, first floor)

WAIT 90 DAYS! DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING ELSE NOW!!!

After 90 days have passed, both plaintiff and defendant must sign the affidavit of consent and the waiver of notice and they must be filed in the prothonotary's office. If the date on your consent is not 90 days after the service, the judge will **NOT** sign your divorce.

File Praecipe to Transmit along with your final decree. A decree should be mailed to you within 4 weeks

I. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE DIVORCE COMPLAINT AND NOTICE TO DEFEND AND CLAIM RIGHTS.

A. Filling out the caption

The caption is the top part of page one of the Complaint and on each legal document you will need to file in the divorce. The names of the parties, the docket number, the type of complaint and the name of the Court are found here.

You are the Plaintiff to this action. Type or print legibly your full legal name, including middle name or initial, above the word "Plaintiff" in the caption of the Complaint and the Notice to Defend and Claim Rights.

The Defendant is your spouse. Fill in the Defendant's full legal name, including middle name or initial, above the word "Defendant" in the Complaint and the Notice to Defend and Claim Rights.

YOU MUST COMPLETE THE CAPTION THE SAME WAY ON EVERY FORM YOU FILE. THE DOCKET NUMBER WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE PROTHONOTARY WHEN YOU FILE THE COMPLAINT.

B. Notice to Defend and Claim Rights

- 1. Complete the caption as above.
- 2. Sign each place on the lines marked plaintiff.
- 3. Fill out your name and address at the bottom of the page.

C. The Following Instructions Correspond to Each Numbered Paragraph of the Divorce Complaint.

- 1. Fill in your full, legal name including the middle initial, your full mailing address (street, number, route, box number, town, county, state and zip code), and the month and year you began living at your current address.
- 2. Fill in the Defendant's full legal name, including the middle initial, the Defendant's full mailing address (street, number, route, box number, county, state and zip code) and the month and year your spouse began living at that address.

- 3. There is nothing to complete in this paragraph.
- 4. Fill in the complete date of your marriage (month, date and year) and the city, county and state in which you were married.
 - 5. If there has been never been a divorce filed during the marriage, write the word "None". If however there was an action filed in the past, write the docket number, the county and state where a complaint in divorce had been filed, who filed the action and what happened with the action (i.e., withdrawn, dismissed, pending, etc.)
 - 6. There is nothing to complete in this paragraph. It is a statement using language needed for a no-fault divorce.
 - 7. There is nothing to complete in this paragraph.

Sign the Complaint using your full, legal name and fill in the date.

Sign the Verification, using your full legal name and fill in the date.

When Assembling these for filing, the Cover Sheet is first, then the Notice to Defend and Claim Rights, then the Complaint. This is the same order they are included in this packet.

II. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING AND SERVING THE COMPLAINT AND IFP

A. FILING THE COMPLAINT AND IFP

You will need to file the <u>Cover Sheet, Notice to Defend and Claim Rights, Complaint, IFP Petition; Affidavit in Support thereof and IFP Order at the Prothonotary's Office, 1st Floor, Mercer County Courthouse, Mercer, PA 16137.</u>

Bring the original and three (3) copies of all the above forms to the Prothonotary's Office. The clerk will stamp all the copies as filed, the original will stay with the Prothonotary. If the IFP Petition is granted, then you will not be responsible for the filing fees. See the included fee schedule for the applicable fees if the IFP Petition is not granted.

B. SERVING THE DIVORCE COMPLAINT UPON THE DEFENDANT

After you have received the copies of the filings back to you. You must within the next 30 days serve the Defendant the Divorce Action. "Service" means that the Defendant received the Notice to Defend and Claim Rights; the Divorce Complaint. The Prothonatary will return two copies of the Cover sheet, the complaint, and the Notice to Defend and Claim Rights back to you. One complete set must be served upon the Defendant in one of three (3) ways, pick one, and must be accomplished within thirty (30) days of filing the complaint.

Mail Acceptance of Service with Complaint for Divorce - Mail Complaint Certified. When you have received the "green" certified receipt of service back from the post office - take it to the Prothonotary along with your Affidavit of Service by Mail. (This is your official proof that the defendant received the divorce complaint. You file this with the prothonotary.

If the defendant signs the Acceptance of Service and returns the same to you, you also must file it with the prothonotary's office. **This is additional proof** that the defendant received the Divorce Complaint.

If the defendant does not claim/receive the Divorce Complaint via certified mail and doesn't return the Acceptance of Service, you have no viable alternative but to request Sheriff's Service of the Divorce Complaint. See "Sheriff's Service Request".

The defendant must receive the Divorce Complaint within 30 days of the date you filed.

1. SERVICE BY CERTIFIED MAIL: This can be accomplished by sending a copy of all required paperwork as mentioned above by <u>certified mail</u>, return receipt requested, restricted <u>delivery</u>. After filing your Divorce Complaint, Notice to Defend and Claim Rights and seminar information, prepare an envelope with your spouse's name and address, using your own address as the return address. Take the envelope to the Post Office and tell them you want to send it "certified mail, return receipt requested, restricted delivery". Someone in the post office may help you prepare the card properly, but if not, here are the instructions: Fill in your spouse's name and address on the back side of the green card. There are boxes on this side for you to check the type of delivery you want. Check the box that indicates that you want a return receipt and the one that indicates that the item should be delivered only to the person whose name is on the envelope (restricted delivery). Fill in your name and address on the reverse side so the green card will be returned to you after your spouse has signed for the envelope.

There will also be a green and white paper slip that is numbered which you will need to complete. Fill in your spouse's name and address. There is a list of blanks indicating fees for the mailing. A postal worker will complete this part for you. The reverse side of the green part of this slip will have adhesive on it. Attach it to the top of the envelope allowing room for the postage. The number on the slip will be filled on the green card where indicated. MAKE SURE TO KEEP THE RECEIPT FROM THE SLIP. The cost of certified mailing will be approximately \$5.50.

IF THE GREEN CARD IS NOT RETURNED TO YOU WITHIN ONE MONTH, contact the post office where you mailed the envelope. If your spouse does not sign for this envelope you should proceed with personal service as described above. WHEN YOUR GREEN CARD IS RETURNED TO YOU, YOU MUST ATTACH BOTH THE GREEN CARD AND THE WHITE SLIP TO A BLANK PIECE OF PAPER. THEN ATTACH THE PIECE OF PAPER TO THE COMPLETED AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE AND FILE IT WITH THE COURT (See Instructions on completing the Affidavit of Service).

2. ACCEPTANCE OF SERVICE: The Defendant may accept service by filing with the Prothonotary a separate document entitled "Acceptance of Service". See forms. If the defendant returns this document to you, you must immediately file it with the Prothonotary.

3. SHERIFF'S SERVICE: Complete the enclosed form for Sheriff's service and take the form and the required documents listed above to the Sheriff's office. There may be an additional fee for this service.

IF SERVICE IS NOT MADE WITHIN 30 DAYS, THEN YOU MUST GO BACK TO THE PROTHONOTARY AND HAVE THE COMPLAINT REINSTATED PRIOR TO SERVICE.

III. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE AFFIDAVIT OF CONSENT AND WAIVER

There are two Affidavits of Consents and Waivers of Notice of Intention to Request Entry of Divorce Decree under Section 3301(c) included in this packet, one for you and one for the Defendant. THE AFFIDAVITS OF CONSENT CANNOT BE SIGNED UNTIL 90 DAYS HAVE PASSED FROM THE DAY YOU SERVED THE COMPLAINT ON THE DEFENDANT. MAKE SURE YOU COMPLETE THE CAPTION OF EACH AFFIDAVIT OF CONSENT AND WAIVER.

PARAGRAPH 1: Print or type

Print or type the date on which the Complaint was filed on both affidavits (the date the Prothonotary stamped on your copy of the Complaint).

Date and Sign the forms for Plaintiff with your full legal name, including middle initial. The second Affidavit of Consent and Waiver for Defendant must be dated and signed by your spouse. Mail your spouse a copy of the Affidavit and Waiver or contact him/her personally. Instruct your spouse to return their signed Affidavit and Waiver to you for filing.

YOU AND YOUR SPOUSE MUST FILE YOUR AFFIDAVITS OF CONSENT WITHIN <u>30</u> <u>DAYS</u> AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN SIGNED. For example, you cannot sign your affidavits one day and file it 45 days later.

File your Affidavits and Waivers with the Prothonotary within 30 days after they have been signed and dated. Remember, both Affidavits and waivers should be filed along with the Praecipe to Transmit Record, vital Statistics Form and Decree.

IV. Praecipe to Transmit Record, Divorce Decree.

A. These forms should be filed at the same time as the Affidavits and Waivers signed by you and your spouse. The court will not grant your divorce otherwise.

After the Divorce Decree has been issued, a woman may resume her maiden name. To do this, she must go to the Prothonotary's Office and file a statement indicating that she intends to resume her maiden name.

If the IFP is not granted, the cost of this filing is currently \$7.50.

Make sure you sign in the presence of a Notary Public.

You cannot retake a Prior Name until after you are divorced. You must reference the date of your divorce decree in the Petition to Retake Prior Name.
