



COVID-19 BANKRUPTCY INFORMATION

IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE AN ACTIVE BANKRUPTCY CASE, YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT YOUR ATTORNEY!

All meetings of creditors that are scheduled will be postponed or held via video conferencing until further notice.

You should call your attorney, or if you don't have an attorney, your trustee, to find out whether your meeting will be postponed or held via video conferencing!

To participate in a telephonic section 341 meeting, you should use the Call-In Number and Passcode assigned to your trustee, which will be posted to the case docket prior to the section 341 meeting date. You should call at least 5 minutes early!

Required documents for the section 341 meeting of creditors should be provided to the trustee a week prior to the section 341 meeting of creditors.

You can still file for bankruptcy, and if you file, the automatic protection from your creditors will still apply, if needed.
