



## **ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS DURING COVID-19**

**If you are out of work or losing hours because of the current public health crisis, you should qualify for Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation.**

### **EXAMPLES:**

- Have your hours been reduced because of the Coronavirus or its impact?
- Have you been temporarily laid off or has your workplace closed?
- Were you sent home due to minor symptoms?
- Do you need to care for a family member?
- Were you fired when you refused to work in unsafe conditions?
- Did you quit to avoid unsafe conditions?

Apply for Unemployment Compensation benefits either at [www.uc.pa.gov](http://www.uc.pa.gov) or call the statewide number at 1-888-313-7284. **Please note that it may be difficult to get through by telephone during high volume times.**

After you have applied for unemployment, you are required to file a claim **EVERY TWO WEEKS** at either [www.uc.pa.gov](http://www.uc.pa.gov) or 1-888-255-4728, **AND** provide the following information:

- Report any hours you worked;
- Report any PTO (Paid Time Off) you received;
- Report any pay you received.
