



ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS DURING COVID-19

SHOULD I FILE FOR REGULAR UC?

- Did you work as an employee in the last eighteen (18) months, **OR**
- Were you both self-employed and an employee in the last eighteen (18) month?

Then you probably should file for regular Unemployment Compensation Benefits if you:

1. Lost your job through no fault of your own; **OR**
2. If you are working less than your full-time hours.

If you have questions about which program you should apply for visit www.uc.pa.gov and review “**Notice of CARES Act Programs Available**” for the Order of Payments on the order of program applications you must follow. **ELIGIBILITY FOR REGULAR UC MUST BE IDENTIFIED BEFORE FILING FOR PUA.**

If you are eligible for regular state UC (in Pennsylvania or any other state); then you cannot claim PUA. Filing for the same claim weeks on more than one program is considered fraud.

Apply for Unemployment Compensation benefits either at www.uc.pa.gov or call the statewide number at 1-888-313-7284. **Please note that it may be difficult to get through by telephone during high volume times.**

After you have applied for unemployment, you are required to file a claim **EVERY TWO WEEKS** at either **www.uc.pa.gov** or 1-888-255-4728, **AND** provide the following information:

- Report any hours you worked;
- Report any PTO (Paid Time Off) you received;
- Report any pay you received.
